Life Skills for Community Living

Especially for students with disabilities, this class helps people to learn and develop practical reading, writing, maths and basic computer skills for use in the community and everyday life.

An overview of this course:

This course develops communication skills for use in the home, the community and the workplace. This course may be part of the educational programs offered at the Centre and lead to further studies and employment for people with a disability.

What you can expect to learn from this course:

- Gain confidence and self esteem.
- Develop communication skills, interpersonal skills and social skills.
- Develop and gain confidence in speaking and reading skills.
- Gain social and cultural awareness.
- Develop personal skills such as reliability, honesty, punctuality, trust, etc.
- Gain confidence in using technology for learning eg. computers and calculators.
- Learn self-management – how to be more organised and learn to work independently.
